WISE: HEAD, HEART AND HANDS HOMESCHOOL ARTS ENRICHMENT INFORMATION SHEET

- 1. This multi-age student centered and teacher led program is designed to offer homeschooled children in grades one through seven the opportunity to engage in Waldorf pedagogical activities with a focus on art, music, drama and nature based learning.
- 2. The 10 month program will run for 24 weeks from late September to mid June, comprising 3 seasonally focused blocks. The program will take place on Mondays from 11:45am to 3:45pm (4 hours).
- 3. Students will bring their own lunch and snacks.
- 4. Parents may be welcomed to attend the classes to support their children and the teachers in weekly activities, at the discretion of the teachers.
- 5. Parents of students with exceptional and/or behavioural needs, should reach out to registrar@thewise.ca to discuss a support plan for participation prior to registering your child. If children are not able to participate in programming independently, parents will be asked to provide the additional supports needed to ensure student and program success.
- 6. This program will run with a minimum of 12 participants and a maximum of 16 participants. Because of the wide age range, two teachers will co-teach the program.
- 7. Program fees will be fully refunded, minus enrollment fees, if notice of student withdrawal is received 7 days or more before the start of the program.
- 8. We invite all parents of homeschool children in the WISE: Head, Heart and Hands Arts Enrichment Program, who are interested in contributing and participating in the WISE community to review the volunteer opportunities that are available throughout the year. (see attached volunteer form)
